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Special Education Advisory Committee

Michigan's <u>Special Education Advisory Committee</u> (<u>SEAC</u>) is the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) mandated state advisory panel to the State Board of Education and the Michigan Department of Education.

- A parent of a child with a disability, less than 26 years of age, who currently receives special education services and has a current individualized education program (IEP), may apply to be a Member at Large
- **34 CFR 300**.167 300.167 State advisory panel. (§300)
