Assistive Technology (AT) can also help students access their right to a Free and Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) in the Least Restrictive Environment (LRE).

This workshop will discuss AT in the Individualized Education Program (IEP):

- Developing a well-written Present Level of Academic Achievement and Functional Performance (PLAAFP) statement to include the difficulties the student is experiencing
- Establishing goals to address difficulties
- Creating an implementation (follow-through) plan
