## Types of Decisions and Tools

**U** Supported Decision-Making  
**TOOLS**

 <p><b>Supported Decision-Making Agreement</b></p> <p>A formal or informal agreement that identifies the people who will support the person in making their own decisions.</p>	 <p><b>Durable Power of Attorney</b></p> <p>Legally authorizes someone to become the decision-maker for an individual in cases where they are not able to decide for themselves.</p>
 <p><b>HIPAA Authorization</b></p> <p>Allows a person to give a supporter the right to see their private medical information.</p>	 <p><b>Assignment of Educational Rights</b></p> <p>Gives consent for parent or guardian to continue involvement and make decisions in their child's educational program after they turn 18.</p>
 <p><b>Educational Disclosure</b></p> <p>Allows a person to share their school information with a parent or guardian.</p>	 <p><b>SSI Representative Payee</b></p> <p>Allows a person who receives SSI to give a supporter the right to manage their money.</p>

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
