Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 is a civil rights law that prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability - this includes students with an Individualized Education Program (IEP).

For students with a disability who are not eligible for an IEP, a 504 plan provides equal access to the general education curriculum.
